- 2. The completed Faith Reference form with its hand-written Reflection Essay.
- 3. A copy of the completed pre-service Religious Education certificate, if available.
- 4. A copy of your Roman Catholic Baptismal certificate (or a Roman Catholic Confirmation certificate if the baptism was in a non-Roman Catholic, Christian denomination).
