SUBJECT:	TENDER APPROVAL – ST. JAMES CATHOLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL - ADDITION			

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board approve the award of tender and the issuance of a purchase order contract for the addition at St. James Catholic Elementary School to Vince Ferro Construction Ltd. at the submitted bid amount of \$740,455.80 plus \$4,410.00 (Separate Price #1), including GST to be funded from 2010-11 Ministry of Education capital project funding.

SYNOPSIS:

The recent Accommodation Review process for west Windsor schools resulted in the Board approving the closure of St. Francis Catholic Elementary School and providing 4 additional classrooms at St. James Catholic Elementary School to accommodate St. Francis Catholic Elementary students. The Ministry of Education approved proceeding with the addition at St. James Catholic Elementary School and a tender was called accordingly. This report is submitted to the Board with the results of the tender and a recommendation for the issuance of a purchase order contract.

BACKGROUND COMMENTS:

A tender opening was held at the Catholic Education Centre on May 14, 2010 with Mario Iatonna, Shannon Ficon, Debbie Maurice, Gerry Racine, Joseph Passa from Passa Associates Inc. and representatives from all nine (9) bidders in attendance. Chair of the Board, Fred Alexander and Trustee Patrick Keane, Ward 2 also attended the tender opening.

A total of nine (9) bids from ten (10) invited bidders were received. These bids are summarized as follows:

The bid submissions were reviewed and were found to be in order. The low bidder meeting specifications is Vince Ferro Construction Ltd. with a bid amount of \$744,865.80.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The costs for this project will be funded from the 2010-11 Ministry of Education capital project funding. At its meeting held April 27, 2010, an amount of \$1.5M was approved by the Board to cover the costs of this project, as well as rehabilitation work to the existing St. James Catholic Elementary School building and improvements to the St. John Catholic Elementary School playground.

TIMELINES:

As stated in the tender documents, the total project is required to be substantially performed and able to be occupied by Friday, August 20, 2010 with all deficiency corrections completed by August 27, 2010.
